

Interview with The Bristol Language Centre University Counsellor - Natasha

Monday 12th July 2010

Magdalena: Natasha, thank you for your time. Tell us please, how many progression routes does The Bristol Language Centre have?

Natasha: At the time of the interview, we have three – one local, one in Wales and one in Leicester (1 hour and 2 minutes from London). By the start of September, we will have more. We are aiming for progression routes with 10 quality UK universities by the end of the year.

Magdalena: What courses are students the most interested in?

Natasha: It is very varied really. Most of our current student body are keen on Masters and I have helped students with Business and Law courses (which are very popular UK courses generally) but even Quantative Analysis, Curatorship and Architecture.

Magdalena: What do you like the most about your job?

Natasha: The teaching aspect is the part I love the most but visiting universities and meeting professors helps me understand where our students are going. They are always beautiful buildings with lush landscapes and exciting developments. It feels like a day off when I go to the universities, even though I am gone for longer and work hard to give a good impression of the school.
